Community college tutition increases

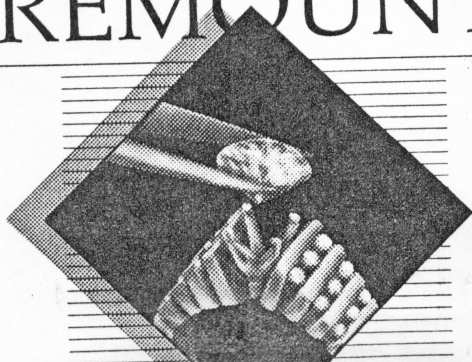
Tuition at Charles County Community College and its branch campuses in Calvert and St. Mary's counties will increase by
