Libraries to help with healthcare enrollment

Libraries throughout Maryland will participate in "Library Enrollment Day" on Saturday, Dec. 10, to help Marylanders sign up for health insurance before the deadline for January coverage.

Maryland Health Connection has partnered with the Maryland Association of Public Library Administrators to provide free, inperson enrollment assistance to consumers at 24 libraries across the state. Consumer assisters will be onsite to answer questions and enroll Marylanders in health coverage through the state's health insurance marketplace.

The Charles County Library Potomac Branch will be participating in the event from 10 a.m.-1 p.m. The library is located at 3225 Ruth B. Swann Drive in Indian Head.

Dec. 15 is the deadline to sign up for health or dental coverage to have it begin on Jan. 1, 2017. Open enrollment for 2017 coverage ends Jan. 31, 2017. Medicaid enrollment is year-round.

Maryland Health Connection is the only place Marylanders can get financial help to cover the cost of health insurance. Last year, nine out of 10 Marylanders received financial help to lower the cost of their plan. Go to MarylandHealthConnection.gov/library for more information or to enroll.
